

FACILITY USAGE

CLASS TYPE DESCRIPTIONS

CLASS I – Use of Facilities for School Related Activities

This classification is for groups that relate to programming of Avon Schools and its students. School related groups shall include such organizations as booster groups, civic groups which directly support Avon Schools, Scouts, 4-H, A.A.U., Avon Soccer Association, Fusion, Avon Junior Miss, AHS Alumni Assoc, and other similar groups. The requesting organization may be charged \$25 per hour for facility usage. Group must have at least 50% of individuals residing in Washington Township.

Class II – Use of Facilities by Civic Groups and Service Organizations

This classification includes non-school related groups that are of value to the community. School facilities may be used by civic groups, service organizations, other schools, churches (for temporary or emergency services only), and other non-profit organizations if the purpose of the use of school facilities is for educational, civic use, cultural or meetings that contribute to the general welfare of the community. These groups would include churches, adult athletic teams, local organized groups related to the arts, civic organizations, and political parties. For this group, a fee will be charged for the rental of the facility and for any necessary custodial or supervisory personnel.

Any fundraising activity sponsored by a Class II organization must be considered as a Class IV project if the proceeds are not entirely dedicated to school related purposes.

Class III – Town, County, State, or Federal Governmental Agencies

Taxpayer supported agencies shall not be charged rental fees, but shall be charged with the necessary supervisory fees as determined by the school corporation. Such agencies as the Town of Avon, county agencies and departments, shall be included in this category. The Extended School Program shall be charged only such fees as is required to pay by law.

Class IV – Use of facilities by groups not assigned Class I, II or III, and any profit realizing activities of any Class II group.

Any private profit-taking agency shall be assigned this classification. For this group a rental fee will be determined based on corporation and/or a percentage of program receipts. In addition, for Class IV groups, fees for any necessary custodial or supervisory personnel shall be assessed the user organization.
