With the online application for the 2014 Woodrow Wilson Teaching Fellowship now open, we need your help. The 2014 WW Teaching Fellowship, to be offered in Indiana, Ohio, and New Jersey, needs strong candidates with a strong STEM background.

For top applicants, the WW Teaching Fellowship offers a \$30,000 stipend toward completion of a Master's Degree in middle and secondary teaching in STEM content at a Woodrow Wilson partner institution in Indiana, New Jersey, or Ohio. Fellows undergo a year-long clinical experience in a high-need school, along with rigorous subject matter courses. They then commit to teaching for three years in urban or rural secondary schools with mentoring throughout the entire process.
